Requirements to be a volunteer vary for each institution, but in general, they look for at least one year of sobriety, a volunteer application, a background check and an orientation that includes meeting staff and the rules and regulations for volunteers. Because of the costs and staff time involved in certifying volunteers, they also ask that you make a commitment to be a regular attender for at least a year.
